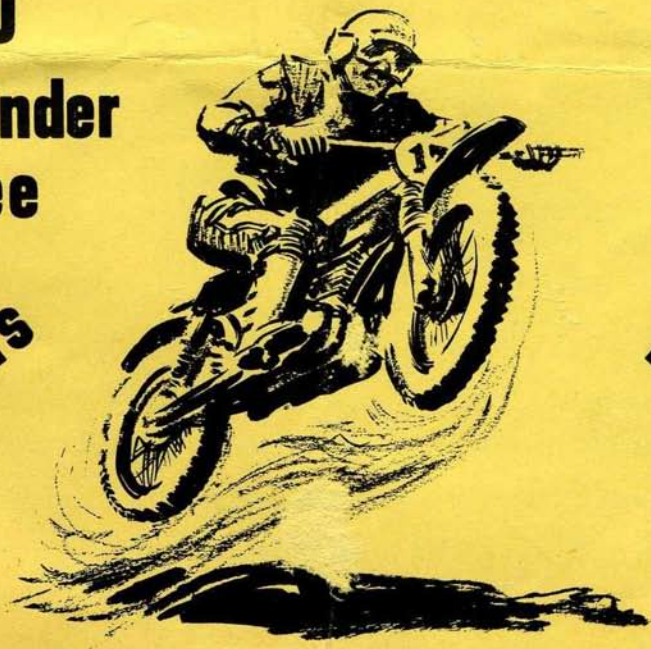

MOTOCROSS -- WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT

To help those of you who have never seen a Motocross race, we shall try to give you a brief description and explanation of what you will be seeing today.

Motocross is held on a dirt track over natural terrain having left and right turns, hills, jumps and mud crossings and is designed to test the contestants skills and endurance rather than the speed of the motorcycle.

Today's events will consist of two races in each class called "Motos". Motos will be approximately ten to fifteen minutes in length. There are three trophies awarded in each Class, winners are determined by adding scores of both Motos.

Riders compete with motorcycles of the same engine size, 100cc class, 125cc class, 250cc class and Open class (251cc and up). Classes are limited to forty bikes per class. If more than forty bikes are present, the class will be divided into additional sections. Each class is separated into two categories based on the riders ability; Yellow plates with black numbers denote Amateurs; White plates with black numbers denote Experts. All riders must be properly licensed. Riders must wear proper equipment; boots, helmets, and long sleeved shirts. Motorcycles are inspected to insure that the machine is properly equipped, (mufflers, etc.) and are safe.

The start is a mechanically controlled rubber band start. Two minute and one minute warning signals are given by the starter. The actual rubber band release is controlled from behind the rider by a trigger mechanism. Race progress and finish flags are displayed as follows:

White Flag - one more lap.

Checkered Flag - finish.
