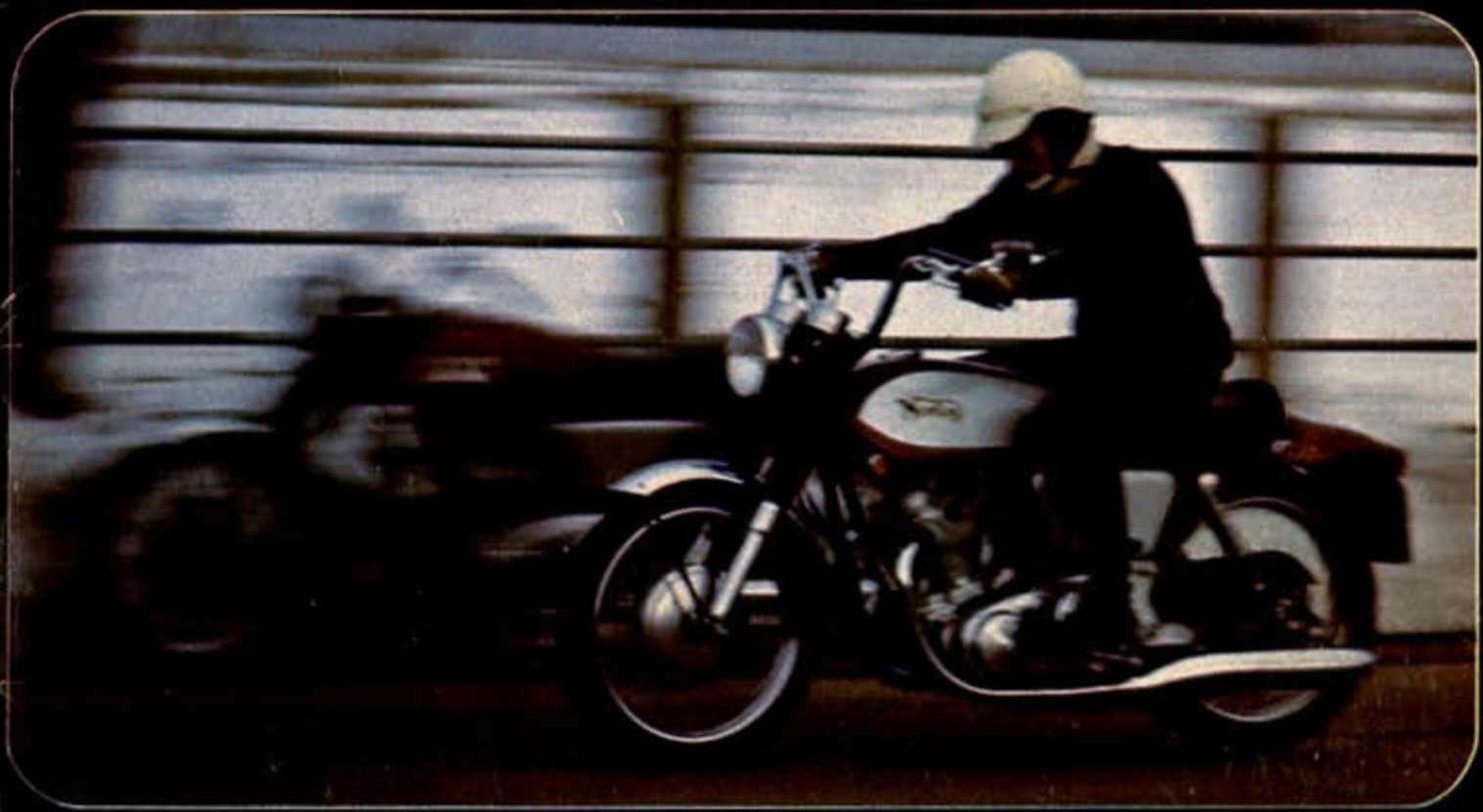

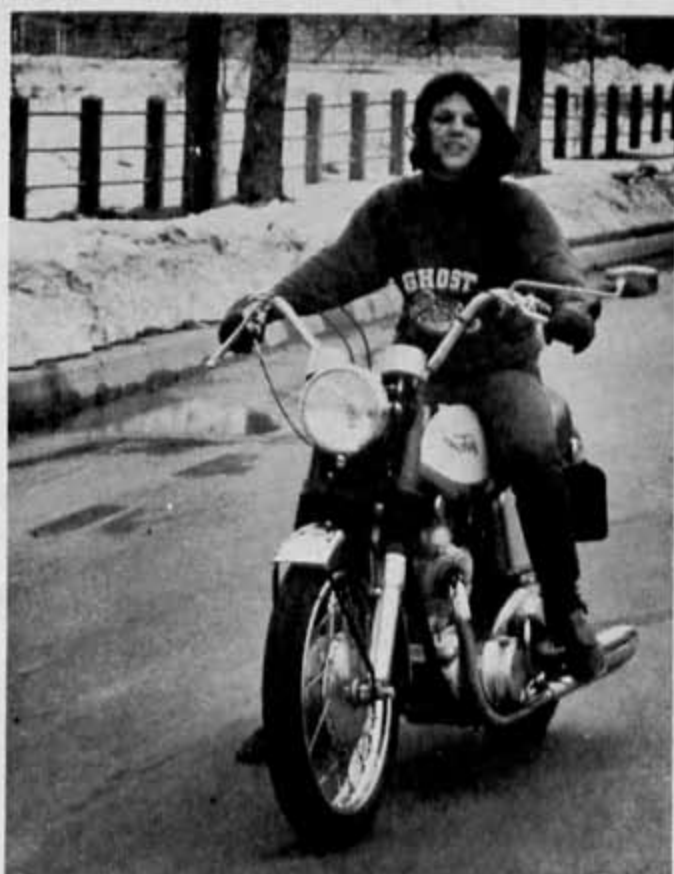

WITH THIS ISSUE, we're starting a new feature: Miss Cyclesport. Our first cycle Miss is Kerry Kleid, a young 5-foot-5-inch bike buff who hails from Rye, New York.

Nineteen years old, Kerry has been riding for the past three years. She started out on a 100cc Bridgestone, and then worked herself up the displacement scale to a 250cc Triumph

Cub, a 250cc Yamaha and a 350cc Ducati. She now owns a '68 250cc dual-port CZ scrambler.

When she bought the Ducati last year, Kerry began to frequent the local

scrambles events. That's where she met Barry Higgins, a veteran scrambler who has a long list of victories to his credit. Barry taught Kerry the basics about scrambling, and it wasn't long before she had stripped the running gear and lights off the Ducati and was blasting around the local tracks.

She bought the CZ from Higgins when he took delivery of his '69 mount. With this machine she has managed to place as high as third in local scrambles against some hot competition.

An enthusiastic scrambles fan as well as a contestant, Kerry travels to all of the big cycle meets. A trip to

the Daytona 200 this year got her interested in road racing, and she has made a down payment on a 650cc Norton road racer.

When she isn't riding cycles, Kerry rides horses. She owns two show horses which she hopes to enter in the Olympics in the near future.
